




After the northern farm's work finished, we came to clinic and went to clinic Consultation at patient's farm with Dr. Senba.

1)upper respiratory endoscopy 2)X-ray for whole limb.

Endoscopy is used to detect the larynx disease.

Laryngeal hemiplegia and DDSP(Dorsal Displacement of Soft Palate) are Common disease in the race horse. That disease makes the horse run worse...

Of course, depend on severity it could be treated by surgery.



<X-ray examination>



X-ray can detect the orthopedic problem. The most important factor in the horse Is limb. So, Doctor must detect the orthopedic trouble in limb in order to solve the Trouble.
